The YMA will hold its 8th annual Islamic Retreat on **Thursday June 26, 2008- Sunday June 29, 2008**. This Islamic retreat is designed for the young adult Muslims in the community and will be held in Columbiaville MI. There we will engage in in-depth Islamic discussions, workshops, recreational activities, late night bon-fires, skits/short films. Guest speakers currently include Imam Sayed Hassan Al-Qazwini, and Sheikh Abbas Virgee.

Our accommodations are located in **Columbiaville, Michigan at the beautiful Camp Taha**. The location provides an Islamic atmosphere where brothers and sisters will reside in separate housing units within close proximity of each other. The facility is private and will be open only to our group. It is surrounded by woodlands, an on-site lake, and is minutes away from the Flint Reservoir.

We will be departing from the Islamic Center of America at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday June 26, and will return on the evening of Sunday, June 29.

The cost for the trip is \$275. This cost will include food, transportation, and lodging. Payment must be made in full prior to departure. Payment plans are available.

The retreat is open to you ages 16-30, with 18 and older holding priority. There are a designated amount of spaces for ages 16-17 that will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. For those under the age of 18, a sibling or caretaker who is at least 18 years old (not a parent) must attend and agree to take full responsibility for the minor at all times. No children are permitted to attend under any circumstances. Absolutely no exceptions will be made.
